[Rail Operator to Open Office in Bulgaria in April](#)

Ljubljana - Slovenian railway operator Slovenske zeleznice will open in April an office in Bulgaria to market its services in conventional and intermodal freight transport, the company said in a press release on Thursday.

The company will cooperate in Bulgaria with company Eurologistics. The deal on the opening of the office was signed on Wednesday by the director of the freight transport section Robert Vuga.

Vuga also signed an agreement introducing a freight line managed by Slovenske zeleznice from Lyon via Ljubljana to the Yana terminal in Bulgaria. The line transporting containers and standard carriages three days a week is expected to be launched in June.

"This year we want to boost railway transport and offer comprehensive logistics services to our customers, primarily to and from Western Europe (Italy, France), the Balkans and Turkey," the press release says.

Slovenske zeleznice will also open in April an office in Prague. The move is part of the rail operator's efforts to spread its sales network to key markets and promote internationalisation of business.
